

PROFILE OF SRI T. V. RAMASWAMY

Sri T. V. Ramaswamy, aged 77, was born in **Nagpur**, with **Madurai** as his nativity. He is a **retired Banker**, a practitioner of **Public Relations**, and a sincere practitioner of **Sanatana Dharmam**.

He is also the **Trustee Secretary of SVP Trust (Sanatana Vedha Dharma Paripalana Trust)**, **Nanganallur, Chennai**, which is engaged in the preservation and propagation of Vedic traditions and runs a **Veda Patashala at Adambakkam, Chennai**.

FAMILY BACKGROUND AND VALUES

Sri T. V. Ramaswamy is the son of **Dr. T. S. Viswanathan**, who served as a Government Doctor.

As a medical practitioner, Dr. T. S. Viswanathan devoted himself primarily to **human healthcare and free service to the society around him**. His commitment was not merely professional but deeply humanitarian.

Consequently, his children were brought up largely in a **rural environment and in a mixed social and cultural atmosphere**, without distinctions based on caste, creed or religion. The family followed a simple and modest way of life within the home and did not seek to exhibit it outside.

These early experiences had a lasting influence on Sri T. V. Ramaswamy and shaped his outlook towards society, human relationships and service.

HIS APPROACH TO SOCIETY

Based upon his own experiences of life, Sri T. V. Ramaswamy feels that there is a genuine need to provide **proper, practical and responsible guidance to people who face grievances, difficulties and uncertainties in their lives**, so that they may understand their circumstances and come out of them successfully.

In today's commercial and increasingly materialistic world, many people become vulnerable to persons who exploit their fears, beliefs and anxieties, particularly in the name of **Astrology, Pariharams and other forms of remedial practices**.

Sri T. V. Ramaswamy therefore seeks to guide people **genuinely, objectively and without exploitation**, helping them avoid being trapped by wrongdoers or by practices that may unnecessarily increase their difficulties.

GUIDANCE FOR BELIEVERS AND NON-BELIEVERS

His approach is intended to be applicable to **both believers and non-believers**.

For those who have faith and belief, he provides guidance and solutions consistent with their beliefs.

For those who do not follow such beliefs, he provides a different set of **simple, practical and rational approaches** suited to their circumstances.

The fundamental objective is not to impose a belief upon anyone, but to understand the individual's situation and provide **simple and practicable guidance according to the person's needs, circumstances and genuine desire for a solution**.

THE PRINCIPLE OF KARMA

Ultimately, Sri T. V. Ramaswamy places emphasis on the **Karma Theory** and on the importance of

understanding the consequences of one's actions.

His approach is therefore intended not merely to provide temporary relief or dependence upon external remedies, but to encourage individuals to understand their own responsibilities, actions, circumstances and choices.

He believes that proper understanding, responsible conduct, practical action and faith—where faith exists—can together help a person face life's difficulties with greater clarity and confidence.
